The Halton Regional Police Service is seeking assistance from members of the public in order to reduce the number of property crimes occurring in our communities. The following simple crime prevention tips are offered to help reduce your chance of becoming a victim:

In Your Home:

- **Always lock all of your doors.** Unlocked garage and man doors, for example, enable thieves to enter homes undetected from the outside.
- Lock your valuables in a safety deposit box.
- Install a loud audible house alarm.
- Secure your safes and lock boxes to the floor.
- Be cautious when allowing people you don't know into your home. Report any suspicious behaviour to police.

- Keep a detailed inventory of your jewellery, including photographs. This will assist officers in the event your property is stolen.
- Check with your insurance company to ensure you have adequate coverage for your valuables.
- Report suspicious people and vehicles in your neighbourhood to police immediately.
- If you encounter someone in your home, **DO NOT CONFRONT THEM.** Call 9-1-1 immediately.

By implementing some of these simple steps you can contribute to making Halton Region as safe tomorrow as it is today.
